Complete Assessment** (If Applicable) The assessment may be waived if your high school or college GPA is 3.0 or higher; or if you have already taken the ACT or Accuplacer. It is important that all transcripts are sent (for review) to determine if the assessment is needed.**	<input type="checkbox"/>
Complete Chemistry (NWTC Catalog #10806134) Chemistry is waived if you have completed two semesters of high school chemistry with a C or better or college chemistry with a C or better.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Complete General Anatomy & Physiology (NWTC Catalog #10806177) General Anatomy & Physiology is waived as an admissions requirement if you successfully complete the HESI.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Complete the HESI (Score of 75%+) Visit http://www.nwtc.edu/HESI for more information! Test subjects include reading, math, biology, and anatomy & physiology. Assessment dates are available in June, September, and January. The HESI is waived if you complete General Anatomy & Physiology with a B or higher.	<input type="checkbox"/>
