FAQs

Q. What is the schedule?

A. The Paramedic Bridge starts every Spring. Once the Bridge courses are completed, students have the option to continue full time or part time into the Nursing Associate Degree.

Q. What if I have transfer credits?

A. A transfer review is automatically completed AFTER you have applied AND submitted your transcripts. If you had fewer then 60 college credits at a C or higher, you must also send your high school transcripts. It can take up to 2 weeks for transfer credits to be processed. If you have completed Nursing CORE courses at another college, you must be in good standing and core courses are reviewed for approval by the health division.
