Submit Transcripts Send high school AND college transcripts (if applicable) to transcripts@nwtc.edu	
Complete Assessment** (If Applicable) The assessment may be waived if your high school or college GPA is 3.0 or higher; or if you have already taken the ACT or Accuplacer. It is important that all transcripts are sent (for review) to determine if the assessment is needed.**

Complete 3,000 work hours* as a Medical Assistant If you are not a certified Medical Assistant, we will accept 6,000 hours or work experience Employment Verification

Submit Background Check/Health Records

When the above courses are completed (or you have enrolled in your final class), visit www.nwtc.edu/cbc to create a CastleBranch account. After you create your account, complete your background check, and upload your immunization records. Failure to complete on time could delay enrollment.

The Medical Assistant to PN program has a limited capacity. Once it fills to capacity, students will be offered a place on a waiting list based on their eligibility date. Once all items on page 1 have been completed, you will be able to accept your position on the waitlist. Wait times change often due to fluctuations in student interest.
