

# **Library Assistant Certificate**

#### Program Code: 905223

This certificate is designed to be an introduction to anyone with an interest in library science. Courses provide an overview of library management, the roles and responsibilities of a library assistant, celebrating children and young adult literary resources, and use media and technology. Courses are delivered online.

#### EDU: Library Science-Introduction, Catalog # 10-522-108

Overview of the library and roles of librarian assistant. Introduces learner to library services/resources, current practices, media and technology, activities to support students, research strategies, communication, and library management.

#### EDU: Technology in Education, Catalog # 10-522-104
